- The first of the local meetings took place in Spey Bay earlier this week, and many thanks to Alistair Gillies, Jim Lauder and Ashley Woodhouse for getting this organised so quickly. Ali's brief report says: *The meeting consisted of 11 T&G, 10 GMB "Britain's best union" and 5 PCS. In the end the group decided our own unions should be more active both nationally and locally. Also we never wish to have a deal imposed again and we think we should go forward with the next pay round and DEMAND the imposition of a deal is not on; neither is the unfair PB issue. Also we want the Non Pay Choices scraped and the money redistributed to our pay deal.*
